



Mary Thomas Memorial ECE Scholarship

WHO CAN APPLY?

If you or someone you know has completed (or is about to complete) a Basic Early Childhood Education program or a Post-Basic Early Childhood Education program with flying colors this school year (2011/2012), celebrate by applying for the Mary Thomas Memorial ECE Scholarship, in honour and fond memory of a highly respected Neskonalith Elder, Mary Thomas. This scholarship is awarded *after* you **complete** your Basic or Post-Basic ECE certificate or diploma program (including all practicum requirements). The goal is to recognize and reward two Aboriginal ECE students each year for the highest academic achievement at an approved educational institution and ECE program within British Columbia. Each year, ACCS offers one \$1500 scholarship for eligible Post-Basic ECE students, and one \$1000 scholarship for eligible Basic ECE students.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

You must meet **ALL** of these eligibility criteria in order to qualify for a scholarship:

- Be enrolled in or just graduated from an approved educational institution and Early Childhood Education (ECE) program – either Basic ECE or Post-Basic ECE Certificate or Diploma – which you have completed or will complete during the 2011/2012 academic year (on or before June 30, 2012).

Alternatively, you can phone 1.888.338.6622 for information about approved institutions & ECE programs; when prompted by the pre-recorded message, choose the option(s) for the ECE Registry.

- Be of Aboriginal ancestry: First Nation (Status, Treaty, or Non-Status Indian), Métis, or Inuit.
- Be a Canadian Citizen or Landed Immigrant, and also provide proof of BC residency (permanently living in British Columbia for six months or more at the time of application).
- Provide an **official copy** of your student transcript or record of grades, which establishes that you have successfully completed a Basic ECE Certificate or Diploma program or a Post-Basic ECE Certificate or Diploma program (successful completion requires a minimum 2.0 grade point average or C grade equivalent in all required courses for completion of your ECE program).
- **An official copy of your student transcript or record of grades must be received by ACCS by July 31, 2012**

You are **not** eligible if:

- You do not provide all required documentation with your application.
- Your application and all required documentation are not *received* by ACCS on or before July 31, 2012.

If you will be completing and receiving your Basic ECE or your Post-Basic ECE Certificate or Diploma after June 30, 2012 (including all required practicum courses) then you should apply for this scholarship in the future, during the academic year in which you complete and receive your ECE Certificate or Diploma.

INFORMATION ON HOW TO FILL OUT YOUR APPLICATION FORM

- For your personal reference and records, keep a copy of the scholarship application form you are submitting, as you may need to amend or refer to it.
- Also for your personal reference and records, keep a copy of your transcript or record of grades and all other required documentation you are submitting.
- Application forms and required documentation submitted to ACCS will not be returned to you.
- Answer all questions on the application form, and attach additional pages and/or documents if space on form is insufficient; sign and date your form and submit to ACCS on or before July 31, 2012.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

- The \$1000 Basic ECE Scholarship will be awarded to the eligible applicant with the highest overall academic standing of all the eligible applicants.
- The \$1500 Post-Basic ECE Scholarship will be awarded to the eligible applicant with the highest overall academic standing of all the eligible applicants.
- These scholarships are available for full time and part time ECE students who are completing or have just completed either a Basic ECE Certificate or Diploma or a Post-Basic ECE Certificate or Diploma at an educational institution with an approved ECE program.
- Scholarship winners will be announced by ACCS in the Fall of 2012. The winners will be contacted by phone or e-mail, and ACCS will also announce the winners on our website, in our e-newsletter and our newsletter, and at our Annual Provincial Training Conference in November 2012.
- Cheques will be issued shortly after the announcement of the winners, and will be mailed to each winner at the address shown on her or his application form.
- A portion of the scholarship amount must be declared as income; ACCS will issue T4A slips to scholarship recipients for the 2012 taxation year on or before February 28, 2013. ACCS will mail T4A slips to each winner at the address shown on her or his application form.
- Submit only **one** application form per person.
