Our Program

These preschool programs are for Aboriginal children ages 3-5 years old and follow the playbased philosophy. We strive to provide curriculum in an Aboriginal context with activities that foster development in social, emotional, physical, spiritual and cognitive skills.

Parent Involvement

Our preschool programs are designed to include parent involvement. We have an open door policy, which means that at any time you are welcome into the centre. Here are some ways we encourage parents and guardians to be involved in the program:

- Come into the classroom and participate in the day's activities.
- Share family traditions and culture.
- Parent, Elder Advisory Committee involvement.
- Join sub-committees.
- Assist with field trips.
- Assist with program and curriculum development.
- Assist with the development of Aboriginal resources.
