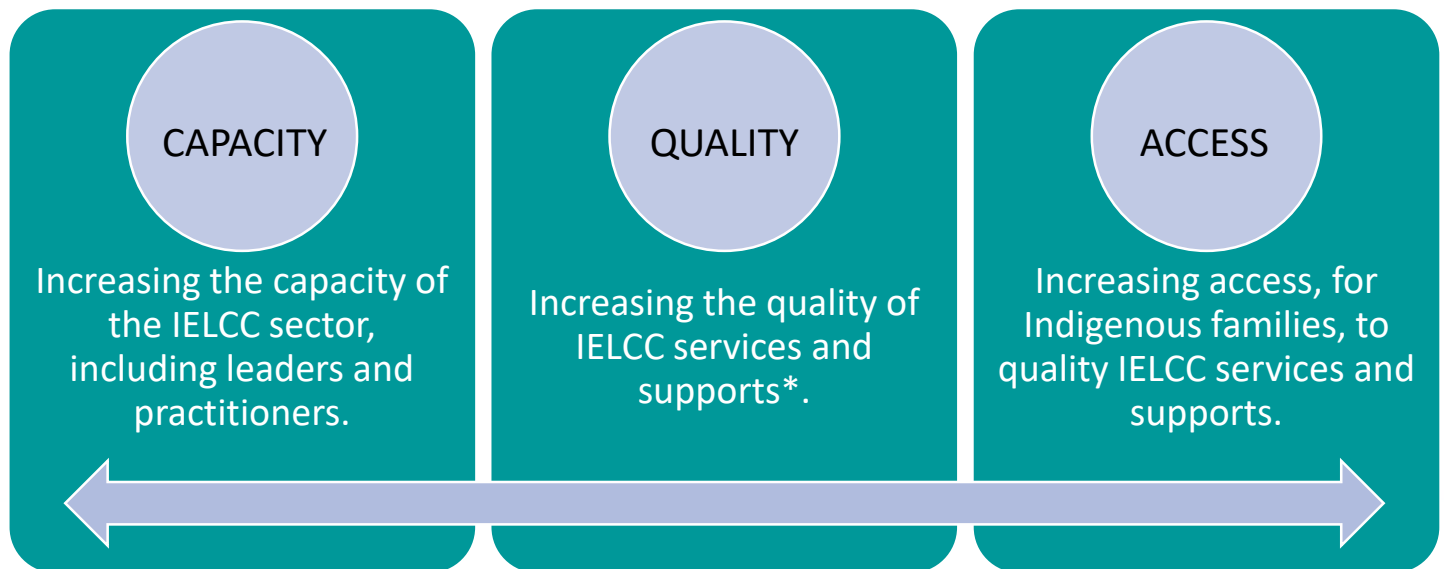




The BC Aboriginal Child Care Society (BCACCS) has been authorized by regional First Nations leadership to be the Regional Coordinating Structure for the implementation and investment of the national Indigenous Early Learning and Child Care (IELCC) Framework (2018) in British Columbia.

As outlined in the IELCC Framework, the focus of investments for the next three years (2018-2021) will fall into one or more of the following three areas of impact/change:

The stated intention is for the IELCC Framework to be a decade-long incremental investment by the federal government (2018-2028). What is outlined in the current strategy is a measured approach, covering the initial two-year funding term – while simultaneously preparing for the remaining eight years of the commitment.

There are three key interconnected and progressive phases, to the investment strategy.
