- Valid First Aid/CPR Certificate.
- Up-to-date record of immunizations and tuberculosis test.
- Statement from a medical practitioner indicating adequate physical and psychological capability to work with children and carry out assigned duties.
- Willingness to participate in work-related courses, seminars and training as required.
- Must maintain regular attendance and be flexible to accommodate changing schedules.
- Must successfully pass a Criminal Records Check.

- Ensure the Infant/Toddler program meets all requirements of the Child Care Licensing Regulations on a daily basis.
- Adhere to the Child and Family Development Centre's philosophy and Schedule D&G of the Child Care Licensing Regulation
- Building a curriculum that is developmentally appropriate for children under 3.
- Prepare activity documentation to support childcare learning
- Cooperate with management and staff to individualize the curriculum and family services.
- Encourage potty training and/or change diapers when needed.
- Supervising while children are eating and bottle feeding
