Job Title: Aboriginal Head Start Childcare Early Childhood Educator- Cook

The six components that guide the care for young children are: Culture & Language Education, Health Promotion, Nutrition, Social Support, Parental and Family Involvement, and Respecting and Honoring every child's spiritual, emotional, intellectual and physical growth.

Job Description

The Cook is responsible for preparing, presenting and serving top quality meals and snacks according to menu specifications based on weekly menu plan.

Responsibilities

- Prepares and submits a list of food program equipment and supplies to restock inventory required for ongoing food program operation
- Develops food/menu plans for breakfast, lunch and dinner menus based on Canada's Food Guide and any special dietary/ allergy requirements with direction from their supervisor
- Determines food quantity and variety, allocates costs and undertakes purchase, transport and proper on-site storage
- Ensures that meals and snacks are cooked and served on time in accordance with schedules
- Disinfect and sanitize, clean kitchen area, and disposal of garbage
- Participated in professional Development

- Must be able to work in a team setting, take initiative, and possess a love for children
- Ability to manage time appropriately
- Ability to use a computer and communicate orally and writing
- Lift and moving equipment and boxes up to 25 lbs.
