Responsibilities include implementing and evaluating activities and experiences within an inclusive learning environment guided by Aboriginal Head Start principles. In addition to having a strong understanding of Aboriginal culture and history, the ideal candidate will have working knowledge of emergent and responsive curriculum.

The ideal candidate will demonstrate their ability to:
