In this role you will encourage, support and collaborate on children and youth's rights to permanency which includes; Adoption, Permanent Transfer of Custody and other Out of Care options. You will promote and ensure the safety and wellbeing of children throughout their stay in care, and will be responsible for recruiting, developing and maintaining a range of resources in which to place Children in Care. In addition, you will assess and approve Out-of-Care placements and provide direct support to Out-of-Care care-providers. You will monitor services provided, support the resource providers, and liaise with staff in district offices. Additionally, you will develop and supervise a comprehensive plan of care, inform the caregiver of their responsibilities, monitor the placement of children, and provide guidance and assistance regarding children's behavior.

Qualifications for this role include:

Applicants may be considered who meet the preferred **OR** expanded credentials and experience requirements

1. Preferred Credentials:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher in Social Work **OR** Child and Youth Care **OR** Master of Education in Counselling Psychology/Master of Arts in Counselling Psychology with completion of a practicum in family and child welfare **OR**
- In-service Ministry of Children and Family Development employees who have a SPO 24-30 base position that requires delegation under the Child, Family and Community Services Act (CFCSA).
- **NOTE:** If this education was obtained outside of Canada, you need to confirm it has been assessed for equivalency through the International Credential Evaluation Services (ICES). You must provide a comprehensive report and the MCFD supplemental report by the closing date of this posting to be considered; **OR** A candidate may be considered equivalent when they are registered and a member in good standing with the BC College of Social Workers or has a letter from the College confirming that their application for registration has been approved.

2. Expanded Credentials:

- Bachelor's Degree in a Human Services field **OR** Bachelor's Degree with a Major/Honors in a Human Services **OR** Master's level graduate Certificate/Diploma in a Human Services field **AFTER** the completion of an unrelated Bachelor's Degree.
- **PLUS**, a minimum of two years of recent related OR job-specific work experience.
- Other combinations of education and experience may be considered.
- **NOTE:** If this education was obtained outside of Canada, you need to confirm it has been assessed for equivalency through the International Credential Evaluation Services (ICES). You must provide a basic report by the closing date of this posting to be considered.
