### **Eagles Nest Early Childhood Educator, Full-time (37 hrs per week)**

#### **Job Summary**

The BC Aboriginal Child Care Society is seeking a full time Early Childhood Educator (ECE) at Eagles Nest Aboriginal Head Start. The ECE will work in a team setting to collaboratively develop and deliver a play-based program. Eagles Nest's program focuses on providing safe, healthy, and culturally rich opportunities for children to participate in indoor and land-based experiences. The ECE will participate in all aspects of the AHS preschool program and ensure that the program meets or exceeds all licensing regulations and reporting requirements. Eagles Nest is a place of learning for children and educators, and staff are encouraged to participate in on-going professional development to ensure that they are always at the forefront of wise practice within the sector.
