There are two (2) positions available, one (1) permanent opportunity, and one (1) temporary opportunity for one (1) year. A permanent appointment may result from this temporary appointment. Flexible work options are available; this position may be able to work up to 2 days at home per week subject to an approved telework agreement.

### **Team Leader, Integrated Services**

The Team Leader, Integrated Services works with diverse community partners to deliver a broad range of services. The position is pivotal in establishing and implementing the multi-disciplinary and culturally appropriate approach to service delivery. This position will provide direction, leadership and support to staff within these teams for professional and integrated services delivery and must ensure adequate clinical support is provided as well as staff training and development.

Employing superior collaborative skills, you establish productive working relationships with community partners and provincial, federal and non-governmental agencies, act as a liaison and participate on internal and external committees as designated by the Director of Operations. A highly effective leader, you focus on staff development, collaborative practices and developing community partnerships.

### **Qualifications for this role include:**

Applicants may be considered who meet the preferred OR expanded credentials and experience requirements

#### **1. Preferred Credentials:**

- Bachelor's Degree or higher in Social Work or in Child & Youth Care **OR** Master's Degree in Educational Counselling Psychology/Master of Arts in Counselling Psychology with completion of a practicum in family and child welfare **OR**
- In-service Ministry of Children and Family Development employees who have a regular full working level SPO 24-30 base position that requires delegation under the Child, Family and Community Services Act (CFCSA).
- At least 2 years of job-specific work experience.
- Experience supervising staff.

#### **2. Expanded Credentials:**

- Bachelor's Degree in a Human Services field **OR** Bachelor's Degree with a Major/Honors in a Human Services field **OR** Master's level graduate Certificate/Diploma in a Human Services field **AFTER** the completion of an unrelated Bachelor's Degree.
- Other combinations of education and experience may be considered.
- Minimum 1 year of related work experience and at least 2 years of job-specific work experience **OR** At least 3 years of job-specific work experience.
- Experience supervising staff.
